Facility

Canine Sport Zone is a premier indoor training facility. It has a large parking lot, lawn, and a green space across the street.

Directions:

- From the North: Take the US-12 south toward Madison. Take the Airport Rd exit (EXIT 250) toward Century Ave/County Hwy M. Turn left onto Airport Rd. and right onto Laura Ln. #3036 Laura Ln is on the left.
- From the South: I-90 W toward Rockford/ I-294 N/Milwaukee. Merge onto US-12 W/W Beltline Hwy W via EXIT 142A on the left toward Madison. Parmenter St exit, EXIT 251B. Enter the US-12 Bus E/Parmenter St roundabout. Turn slight right onto Parmenter St/US-12 Bus W. Turn left onto Donna Dr (Culver's). Turn right onto Laura Ln. #3036 Laura Ln is on the left.
- From the East: From Milwaukee take I-94 West. Keep left to take WI-30 toward Madison/Janesville. Merge onto US-12 W/W Beltline Hwy W via EXIT 142A toward Madison. Take the Parmenter St exit, EXIT 251B. Enter the US-12 Bus E/Parmenter St roundabout. Turn slight right onto Parmenter St/US-12 Bus W. Turn left onto Donna Dr (Culver's). Turn right onto Laura Ln. #3036 Laura Ln is on the left.

Parking

- Parking is available in the Canine Sport Zone lot and on Laura Lane.
- Due to COVID restrictions, all dogs and people in attendance will remain outside of the building unless heading into the ring.
- Canopies, lawn chairs and kennels should be set up on grassy areas outside of the building. A green space across Laura Lane is available for setting up.
- We recommend setting up a county area for participants to encourage outdoor camaraderie and support during the competition.
- An area on the street will be blocked off to allow for safe passage for those crossing the street between the facility and park.

Dog Exercise Area

- There will be specified exercise areas outside; look for signs.
- \$10 fee for eliminating in ring/inside the building

Registration Information and Entry Fees

Entry Fees

- The entry fee for participation in this event is \$20 for the first class, \$10 for second and \$10 for the third class.
- You may enter up to <u>TWO</u> dogs in classes in up to 3 classes each.

Registration for Exhibitor

- Attach a copy of the Rabies certificate
- Write your check out to your own county's 4-H Dog Project or County 4-H Office
- Collect all 3 signatures on the back of each entry form.
 - This signature verifies that the exhibitor is enrolled in the 4-H Dog Project, the classes chosen are correct, the Rabies certificate is up-to-date, and the dog has exhibited acceptable behavior.

County Paperwork

- One check should be written by the County 4-H Dog Project or County 4-H office equal to the fees of all exhibitors.

- Championship awards will given to the top dog/handler team in each class of: Standard Tunnelers, Advanced Tunnelers, JTT-A, JTT-B, Advanced JTT, Standard Agility A, Standard Agility B, and Advanced Standard Agility.

Scoring for Agility

- 1. Each course is worth a maximum 100 points.
- 2. A score of 70 or higher is considered a Qualifying Score in all classes of 4-H agility.
- 3. A penalty consists of the loss of 5 or 10 points.
- 4. 10 point penalties (judge holds up two hands) include: not making contact in contact zones, not doing the obstacles in proper order or not completing an obstacle, the handler going over the obstacle with the dog, or missing one or more weave poles. Obstacles may **not** be re-attempted.
- 5. If a handler loses control of their dog while on the course, it will be considered a 10 pt. penalty.
- 6. 5 point penalties (judge holds up one hand) include: knocking down a jump bar, excessively guiding the dog with leash (max of 3 penalties), touching the dog, or touching the obstacle.
- 7. Failure to follow judge's verbal instructions is a 5 pt. penalty.
- 8. Any interference or outside assistance that aids the dog or is intended to aid the dog or handler will be considered a 5 point penalty.
- 9. Excessive or harsh commands or corrections will not be allowed. This will be a 5 pt. penalty.
- 10. The dog/handler team's run will be timed. A 5 point penalty will be given for going over the course time limit and an additional 5 points for each 15 seconds over the course time. After 60 seconds of additional time the handler will be asked to leave the course immediately and will be given a 25 point time penalty and a 10 point penalty for each obstacle not completed.
- 11. Refusals or run-by's will not be faulted in 4-H. A handler may redirect the dog to obstacle.
- 12. The only penalty for breaking a sit or a down on the pause table is the extra time that accumulates when the count stops, and is not resumed, until the dog is back in position.
- 13. The contact zone on the A-frame, dog walk and seesaw is the contrasting colored zone (usually yellow) on the start and end of each obstacle.
- 14. Any dog that commits to a contact obstacle (A-frame, dog walk, seesaw) with all four paws must, for safety reasons, continue with the obstacle. Whether the obstacle is completed or if the dog jumps off, the dog and handler must go on to the next obstacle and may not attempt that obstacle again.
- 15. The teeter totter may be touched and guided downward in the Standard Agility class only. The Advanced Agility class does not allow for any obstacles to be touched.
- 16. If the judge determines that a dog is no longer working with the handler, the team will be excused from the course. No score will be given. (DQ)
- 17. Un-sportsman-like conduct will not be tolerated. This will be a disqualifying penalty and the handler and dog will be excused from the competition with a DQ.
- 18. If the dog urinates or defecates in the ring (from the time it enters until it leaves the ring), the dog and handler will be disqualified from that class with a DQ. A \$10 fee will be collected after each incident.
- 19. In the case of a tie in total points, the fastest time will win.

Both JTT and Standard Agility will be divided into two divisions - A and B.

<u>Division A</u> - In this division, neither the dog nor handler has previously achieved a qualifying score in 4-H agility or another agility venue. In addition, neither the handler nor the dog has previously achieved a title in another agility venue.

<u>Division B</u> - This division is designed for those where either the dog or handler have achieved a qualifying score in 4-H agility or another venue OR for those situations where either the handler or the dog has earned an agility title in another venue. Receiving a qualifying score in either JTT or Standard means that the dog/handler team should be entered in Division B in both JTT and Standard in future competitions.
