

Requirements for Hosting the State 4-H Agility Show:

Counties that are considering hosting the State 4-H Dog Agility Show, should be prepared to offer the following:

- 1) Two rings, either indoor or outdoor, each of which is at least 100 X 75 (or an equivalent square footage). If indoor, there must be appropriate flooring to provide the dog/handler teams with traction and cushion. Counties that wish to offer an indoor show are encouraged to check with local training centers or kennel clubs.

- 2) Equipment minimums: (see AKC rules for equipment construction specifications)
 - 15 – 20 single bar jumps, some with wings
 - 1 Double jump
 - 1 Triple jump
 - 1 Tire jump
 - 2 open tunnels
 - 1 closed tunnel
 - 1 Pause table
 - 1 Seesaw
 - 1 A-frame
 - 1 Dog Walk
 - 12 Weave Poles (that can also be used as 6 weaves)

Optional equipment that could also be used in Advanced Classes:

- Broad Jump
 - Panel Jump
- 3) Workers (during the runs**)
 - Judge
 - Gate steward
 - Leash runner
 - Scribe
 - Timer
 - Back-up timer
 - 2-3 Bar Setters/Chute Straighteners

**Areas needing workers at other times include registration and course building.

- 4) Not required, but “a plus”:
 - Camping
 - Foodstand
