- Counties can enter more than one team in any age division.
- Youth can be on one team only in each discipline archery, air rifle, and wildlife.
- Youth must compete in the age division as registered in the tournament when a member of a team. Your entry age division
  must be the same through the tournament (archery, air rifle, wildlife, & wildlife art). (Exception NQ).
- Only acceptable team names can be used. We reserve the right to change your team name without notification.
- o Teams must register on this form only by the registration deadline. No team member changes after March 11, 2023.

<u>Archery Team Competition</u>: No fee required; four members (three minimum) from same county use their individual scores to tabulate this class. Recurve, Compound, and Longbow scores can be used on the same team. Counties can enter more than 1 team; each archer can only be on one archery team. Circle your archery class to be used for team competition on your individual registration form or the 1<sup>st</sup> class registered will be used.

You may need to identify these from tracks, furs, skulls or pictures as well as their homes/habitat and foods, management practices, etc. WI trees/leaves, wildflowers, and weeds identification. Hunting regulations – ethics and activities. Other related topics: orienteering, compass readings, determining distances, directional map questions, picture questions.
